It is shown in our willingness to help other communities and YMCA's who seek to offer YMCA programs and continue to be relevant in their communities. The Board has approved our outreach to the community of Gonzales to explore the possibility of offering programs to their residents. They have also entered into a management agreement with the YMCA of the Coastal Bend to help them continue impacting the community of Corpus Christi.
